She was always doing good and helping the poor. She became sick and died.

But it had always been at the command of the One who is “the Resurrection and the Life.” This was new territory for Peter, so he may have been a little apprehensive at first. But when the Lord returns and orders us to arrive, it will be with all the confidence of the omnipotent God. The RESULTS of Peter’s command was Tabitha’s resurrection.

Tabitha’s Resurrection – Acts 9:36-43 - Calvary ...

Commentary on Acts 9:36-43. This passage begins with the words, “in Joppa there was a certain female disciple (mathetria) by the name of Tabitha, which being translated (into Greek) also means Dorcas. Her life was full good (agathos) works (erga) and necessities for the poor (eleemosunon), which she herself provided” (Acts 9:36, my translation).

Acts 9:36-43 Resurrection Legacy Call her Tabitha – or call her Dorcas, if you happen to favor the Greek. Whatever name you use, understand that she was a pillar of the early church in Joppa, a town which was about 30 miles northwest of Jerusalem.

All the widows stood beside him, weeping and showing tunics and other clothing that Dorcas had made while she was with them. Peter put all of them outside, and then he knelt down and prayed.

Then, in 9:42, Luke tells us that the result of the raising of Dorcas was that many believed in the Lord. Luke is showing how the gospel of Jesus Christ spread, resulting in the salvation of many. Thus I believe that he wants us to view these miracles as spiritual lessons of the power of the gospel to transform sinners.

Chapter 9 began with Saul’s Damascus road vision and his subsequent conversion (vv. 1-19a)—his preaching in Damascus synagogues (vv. 19b-22)—his escape from Jews who were plotting to kill him (vv. 23-25)—and his journey to Jerusalem and subsequent escape from a second plot to kill him (vv. 26-30).

Acts 9:32-43, read it aloud... Acts begins with the resurrection ministry of Jesus and his promise of the Holy Spirit. Jesus appears to a multitude of people in his glorified body, gives instruction to wait for a gift that the Father has promised, and then ascends into heaven. So the apostles wait, and the Pentecost happens.

In verse 43 Luke adds what seems like an unimportant footnote, but actually it is an indicator of the great work God had already done in Peter in preparing him for what was to occur very soon. 43 And it came about that he stayed many days in Joppa with a certain tanner, Simon.

B. Raising Tabitha (9:36-43) While Peter is in Lydda, there is a disciple named Tabitha in Joppa who was always doing good works and acts of charity. But Tabitha became sick and died. Since the city of Lydda is near Joppa, the disciples in Joppa sent two men begging Peter to come to Joppa.
