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Lecture And Note Taking Guide

Use a loose-leaf notebook rather than a notebook with a permanent binding. See the pattern of a lecture by spreading out the pages. Write name and date of the class on the first sheet for each lecture. Use 8 1/2 x 11 sheets of paper for your notes. This size will allow you to indent and see the structure of your notes.

Format: Record the date, place, topic/title and presenter. Number your pages. Use dark ink and write on one side of the page. Use a double entry notetaking system (see "Cornell Notetaking System" handout) Write neatly. Make notes complete and clear enough to understand when you come back to them. ...

All notes from the class go into the main note-taking column. The smaller column on the left side is for comments, questions or hints about the actual notes. After the lecture, you should take a moment to summarise the main ideas of the page in the section at the bottom which will speed up your reviewing and studying process immensely.

The Best Note-Taking Methods. For college students ...

The paper is divided into 3 sections: a 2.5" margin to the left, a 2" summary section on the bottom, and a main 6" in-class note section. Use the main notes section to take notes during class. Use the cues section to review your notes. After class, write down things you'll need to remember and a prompt for each.
