The main goal of physical therapy during TBI rehabilitation is to retrain the nervous system to control normal muscle movement. After a brain injury, the connection between the brain and muscles can become damaged or destroyed. Fortunately, engaging the brain's neuroplasticity allows you to rebuild those neural connections.

In the most severe form of TBI, the entirety of the brain is affected by a diffuse type of injury and swelling. Treatment modalities vary extensively based on the severity of the injury and range from daily cognitive therapy sessions to radical surgery such as bilateral decompressive craniectomies.
